 - ii. A player may play in two categories in league play
 - iii. Make sure that players stay so that all the players have the opportunity to play in a courtesy match
 - e. Sportsmanship ballot—emailed with agenda—will be collected at the seeding meeting
 - f. All-league criteria
 - i. Wins & losses; in case of tie then consider head-to-head competition
 - ii. Coach discussion
 - iii. If still tied, blind vote

 - i. Season record, wins and losses
 - ii. Any level competition—singles, doubles or mixed doubles
 - iii. Each coach should bring team match sheets to compare wins and losses
 - iv. Each coach may speak about their MVP nominee for no more than one minute
 - v. MVP should be the BEST player in the league; in other words, a team MVP may not necessarily be the NBL MVP
